## DID YOU KNOW ...

**Q. What does it mean to have the name of a loved one mentioned at Mass?**

**A.** An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. When a priest offers Holy Mass, he has three intentions: First, to offer the Mass reverently and validly in accord with the norms of the Church. Second, to offer the Mass in union with the whole Church and for the good of the whole Church. Third, to offer the Mass for a particular intention, such as the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

**Q. How can I arrange to have the name of a loved one said at Mass at St. Peter's church?**

**A.** The proper term used for having a name mentioned at Mass is **Mass intention**. (**PLEASE NOTE:** Weekend Mass intentions are for loved ones whose death has occurred **MORE THAN one year ago**). First, determine the Sunday Mass time you would like to attend. Second, contact the parish office in order to request a **Mass intention** be added to the Sunday Mass desired. Third, the parish office will advise if that date and time is possible or if further accommodations need be discussed. Due to the amount of weekly intention requests, there is a maximum amount of intentions permitted. Should this occur, rest assured that the parish office will look to schedule your intention on a date and time closest to your original choice.

**Q. Are Mass intentions permitted during the week?**

**A.** Mass intentions are accepted for loved ones **ONLY FOR:**  
- the **1<sup>st</sup> month anniversary** of their death;  
- the **1<sup>st</sup> year anniversary** of their death.

Due to the high number of parishioners, it may not be possible to schedule a memorial mass on a specific date desired. It is recommended you to contact the parish office **no earlier than FOUR MONTHS BEFORE** the 1<sup>st</sup> year anniversary date.

*We must remember that the celebration of Holy Mass is the main importance when arranging a Mass intention or memorial Mass. The actual date that it is celebrated on does not affect the importance or validity of the Mass. One must never forget the infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefits one's soul.*
