 - ❖ Certificates are not kept on file and must be resubmitted upon registration for all Sacraments requested.

- If two godparents are chosen, one is to be a man and the other a woman. (Code of Canon Law, 873)
- The intended godparent(s) must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. (Code of Canon Law 872)
- The intended godparent(s) must be at least 16 years of age to undertake this role. (Code of Canon Law 872)
- The intended godparent(s) must be in good standing with the Catholic Church (eg. not married outside of the Catholic Church and a practicing member). (Code of Canon Law 872)
- The intended godparent(s) was not divorced and remarried. (Code of Canon Law 872)
