### Follow Instructions Carefully...



#### Confirmandi,

As part of your preparation, you are asked to complete a reflection on the Gospel reading assigned for each Sunday. Attached, are a series of sheets that are to be completed <u>individually</u> each week at home, and brought to Church on a weekly basis.

- \* These reflections will <u>require you to have the use of a Catholic Bible</u>. The New Revised Standard Version (NRSV) is the official English translation of the Bible for the Church in Canada. It differs from the RSV in its use of inclusive language ("fishers of people" instead of "fishers of men"). The Good News Bible (GNT) uses simpler English and accepted as well.
- \* Be sure to CLEARLY print your full name and school name on each of your reflection sheets.
- \* Each sheet will contain a different Bible passage for reflection. Bible passages are identified by book, chapter, and verse, (for example, Ex 3:1-4). The name of the book comes first. It is often in abbreviated form. Your Bible's table of contents will help you determine what the abbreviation means. In this example, Ex stands for Exodus. After the name of the book, there are two numbers. The first one identifies the chapter, which in our example is chapter three; it is followed by a colon. The second number identifies the verse or verses, which in our example are verses one to four.
- \* Slowly and thoughtfully, read the Gospel passage the first time. What word or phrase captures your attention and grabs your heart? Reflect on the reading. Slowly and prayerfully, read the passage again. What is God saying to you in this passage? Offering you? Asking you? What feelings are arising within you? Slowly and prayerfully respond to God from your heart. With this in mind, complete your reflection based on the two questions on your sheet.
- \* Each reflection sheet is to be brought to Mass on the weekend that corresponds to the date at the top of the sheet. (Example: reflection sheet with the date of September 27 and 28 at the top of the page is due to be completed AT HOME and BROUGHT TO MASS on the weekend of September 27 and 28 (to any of the weekend Mass times). ALL REFLECTIONS are to be completed and brought to church on a weekly basis.
- \* Following Mass, a volunteer(s) will be present to stamp your sheet and submit it to both Fr. Charles / Fr. Joshua for review. The <u>weekly reflections will be monitored for attendance and completion</u> on an ongoing basis. <u>Failure to complete the reflections will result in post-ponement of receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation</u>.
- \* We ask that you do not bring any of the completed sheets to the parish office as they will be not accepted. They are to be stamped and submitted following any of the weekend Masses.
